COMMUNICATIONS FIJI LTD UPGRADES TRANSMISSION IN THE NORTHERN DIVISION

The South Pacific's leading radio broadcasting organisation Communications Fiji Ltd (CFM), announced today that they had completed transmission upgrade work of their broadcast signals in the Northern Division.

Commenting on the announcement, CFM General Manager for Fiji, Mr lan Jackson, said that the upgrade had resulted in a dramatic improvement of signal strength in Southern Vanua Levu and Taveuni where listeners to all five CFM stations Viti FM (92.0), FM96 (96.0), Legend FM (98.4), Navtarang (100.8) and Radio Sargam (103.2) now enjoy strong coverage of the region.

In addition, CFM has also redesigned its network to improve delivery of programming to the Northern Division from its Suva based studios. "Working with Vodafone Fiji, we are now delivering a fully digital service to our transmitters in the North. This means higher quality radio and much improved reliability particularly in bad weather", added Mr Jackson.

Recently Communications Fiji Ltd teams toured the region hosting live broadcasts in partnership with the Poverty Alleviation Team from the Prime Minister's Office; "We were delighted with the response to our stations right across Vanua Levu and Taveuni", said Mr Jackson.

Communications Fiji Ltd has invested over a quarter of a million dollars in the upgrade work in 2012 following on from an investment of over \$500,000 in 2011. "This reflects the commitment of the shareholders of Communications Fiji Ltd to continuous improvement of our broadcast operations in Fiji ".

The Communications Fiji Ltd engineering team are now finalising plans for the next round of investment and upgrading projects to commence early 2013.
