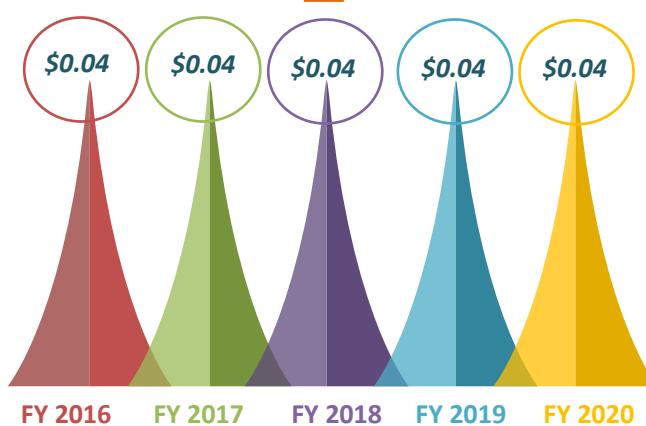

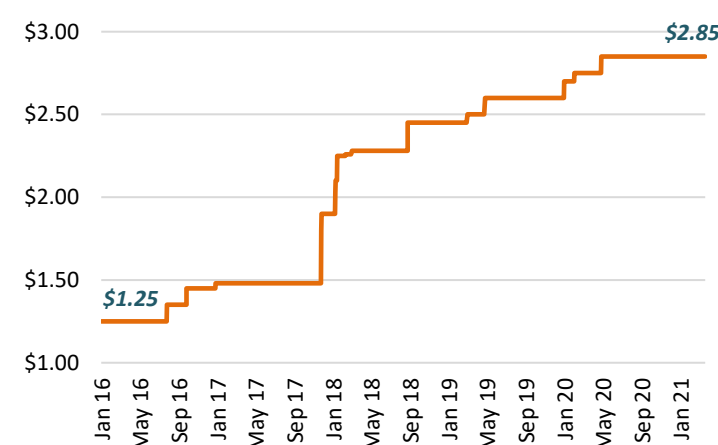
DIVIDEND PAYMENT HISTORY

From 2016 until 2020 (based on financial year)

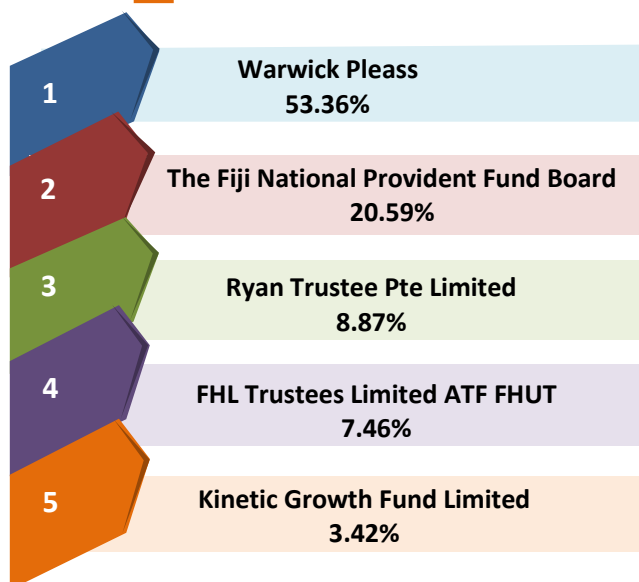


SHARE PRICE MOVEMENT

From 2016 until the most recent

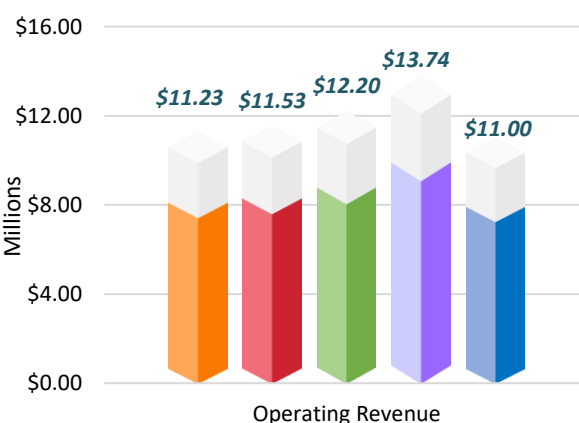

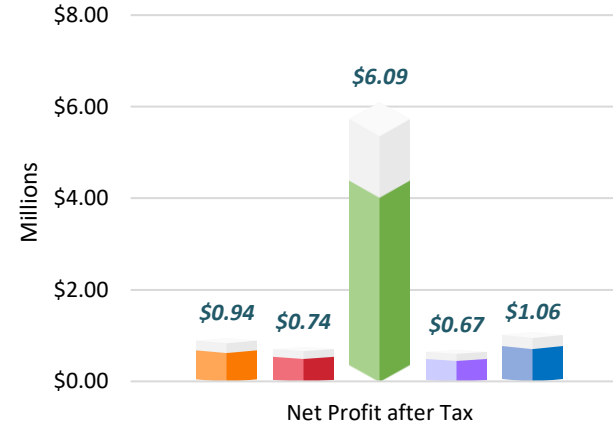


FINANCIAL FIGURES TREND (over past 5 years)

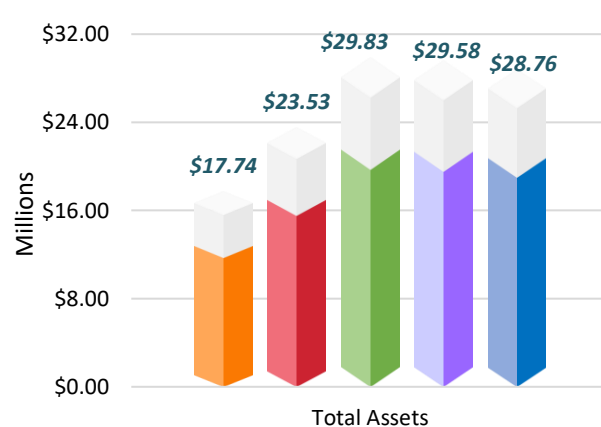

Dividend Reinvestment Plan (DRP)

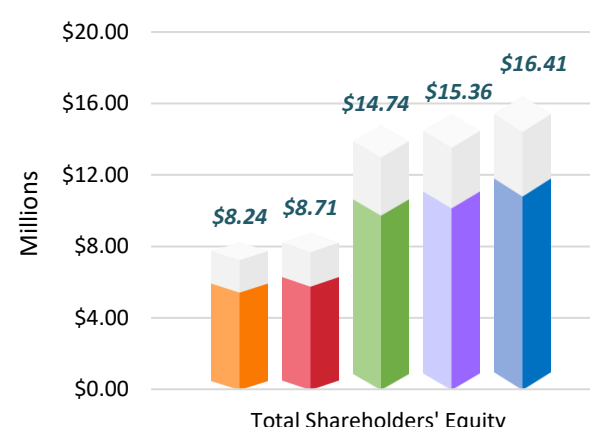
