- Arrival of new students

Further to our market announcement on 2 February 2021, we are pleased to announce the arrival of over 100 students to Fiji on our charter flight yesterday. The charter flight details are shown below.

Chief Operations Officer, Mereseini Baleilevuka said, “We are fortunate to have over 100 students coming to Fiji to study on this charter flight. It shows that there is still a demand for study abroad programmes during this pandemic, however, this does not mean that that demand will easily translate to sales. The cost to study abroad still remains a challenge for our business but we are grateful that we are able to remain operational during these difficult times.”

We can also confirm that all 108 students have undertaken their first PCR test in Japan and have all returned a negative result prior to their departure from Japan. These students are now in quarantine for 14 days and will again undertake two mandatory PCR test during their stay.

They are expected to complete their quarantine by 2 May 2021 and are expected to commence classes from 3 May 2021.

We thank all the relevant authorities of the Fiji Government, Air New Zealand and our teams for their support and assistance during this time.
