Fiji TV secures broadcast rights to the Tokyo Olympics

Fiji Television Limited FijiTV wishes to announce that it has secured the rights to broadcast the Tokyo Olympics on its Free to Air channel, Fiji One.

The Summer Olympics is an international multi-sport event that's held every 4 years. The Tokyo Olympics was originally scheduled to take place in 2020, the event was postponed as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and rescheduled to be held from 23 July to 8 August 2021. This is the first time that the Olympic Games have been postponed and rescheduled, rather than cancelled.

The Tokyo 2020 will mark the second time that Japan has hosted the Summer Olympic Games, the first being also in Tokyo in 1964, making this the first city in Asia to host the Summer Games twice.


