ClimateCare is a weather index microinsurance product developed and piloted to respond to the

growing need for insurance solutions to address economic impacts of natural hazards in the Pacific

region. The main aim of this parametric microinsurance product is to increase the Pacific Islands

disaster risk management capacities and improve their financial resilience. FijiCare's ClimateCare is

designed to provide immediate monetary relief to those insured members who are covered under the

scheme for loss of income arising out of natural disasters such as cyclones and flooding.

Fijian Government, PICAP and UNCDF. Parametric microinsurance product is an extension of the

solution, where all insured members who fall within the defined geographical parameters of the

extreme weather event like cyclone will qualify for a claim pay-out based on pre-defined trigger events.
