The 31<sup>st</sup> Monaco Yacht Show, held at the renowned Port Hercules in Monaco in late September 2022, was attended by Port Denarau Marina and Tourism Fiji. The Monaco Yacht Show, the premier superyachting event in the world, is an important B2B event for industry executives which draws close to 35,000 guests over four days and features more than 450 top luxury yachting brands and around 115 superyachts including 40 new models. Yacht owners, potential buyers or charterers of superyachts, and decision-makers from the yachting and luxury industries attend the Monaco Yacht Show for four days to engage in one of the most influential business networks. This event is important for Fiji Yachting as we work to attract superyachts to visit Fiji and showcase the beauty and facilities that Fiji and the

South Pacific have to offer. The marina returned to the show after two years of travel limitations; we have been a part of this event for the past decade.

The South Pacific stand was once again the highlight of the event, with our Fijian warriors and Cook Island dancers generating a flurry of excitement around our stand as they walked the show and exhibited our uniqueness. This year, Fiji joined forces with Australia, Tahiti, and the Cook Islands under the South Pacific stand as part of a coordinated marketing strategy to encourage superyachts to visit the Southern Hemisphere.

On the eve of the Monaco Yacht Show, the Asia Pacific Superyacht Association (APSA) organized Asia Superyacht Night, which was attended by more than 150 invited guests. Port Denarau Marina served as the event's silver sponsor.

A significant number of superyachts have indicated they will include the South Pacific in their travel plans over the next two years, making the event successful for Fiji and Port Denarau Marina. A 51-meter superyacht is due to visit us in November and will stay during the off-peak season. Since the revision in our charter regulations, we have noticed a clear trend in the visitor profile, including a wider age and country range, and genuine aspirations to charter.



We appreciate Tourism Fiji's Jane West and Roberta Rho, the French Rugby Club's John Tuilakepa, and Mala Ravulo as our Fijian Ambassadors, whom all helped make this show a success. As Fiji's top marina and a favorite stop for visiting superyachts, Port Denarau Marina continues to lead the way forward as a favored destination by visiting superyachts.

#### **About Port Denarau Marina:**

Denarau Island in Fiji, about 20 minutes by car from Nadi International Airport, is home to the widely acclaimed Port Denarau Marina. Since it acts as the gateway to the Mamanuca and Yasawa Group, Port Denarau Marina, in the heart of the integrated Denarau Island, serves as the beginning point for visiting our gorgeous, sun-drenched tropical isles off the west coast of Fiji.



In addition to having an international 18-hole golf course and being close to several international hotels, Port Denarau Marina is also a part of the biggest shopping and dining complex in the Nadi region.

The marina complex is the hub of yachting activity in Fiji and is reached by a clearly designated channel that is 5 meters deep at low tide.

The marina has excellent weather protection. The basin has 56 commercial berths, 16 swing moorings, and 56 fully serviced private berths, 20 of which can accommodate superyachts up to 85 meters in length. The dock provides internet, single-phase and three-phase power, fuel, and water. A haulout facility with a 50-ton travel lift, a hard stand area, and marine workshops are also part of the facility.

Provisioning is simple thanks to the grocery, pharmacy, and bakery at the end of the dock and the close proximity of Nadi and Namaka by bus or taxi. Port Denarau is perfectly situated to serve as a stopover for relaxation, entertainment, and resupply while you are traveling through the Fijian Islands.
