Tonga's First Parametric Microinsurance launched by FijiCare

FijiCare Insurance Limited ("FijiCare") is pleased to announce the launch of ClimateCare in Tonga, the country's first parametric microinsurance product with the support of the Tongan Government, the United Nations Capital Development Fund led Pacific Insurance and Climate Adaptation Programme (PICAP). After the successful launch and pilot of ClimateCare in Fiji and recently in Vanuatu, the product has now been expanded to Tonga. ClimateCare is a weather index microinsurance product developed and piloted to respond to the growing need for insurance solutions to address economic impacts of natural hazards in Pacific region. The main aim of this parametric microinsurance product is to increase the Pacific Islands disaster risk management capacities and improve their financial resilience. ClimateCare is designed to provide immediate monetary relief to those insured members who are covered under the scheme for loss of income arising out of natural disasters such as cyclones.

FijiCare Executive Director, Mr. Avi Raju commented on the launch, "We are thrilled on the expansion of ClimateCare to Tonga, this is an inclusive and innovative solution, made possible by the collaborative efforts of the Tongan Government, Tonga Development Bank, PICAP and UNCDF. ClimateCare parametric insurance is a unique insurance solution, where all insured members who fall within the defined geographical parameters of the extreme weather event like cyclone will qualify for a claim pay-out based on pre-defined trigger events. At FijiCare, we are committed in providing innovative insurance solutions across the Pacific region."

The Programme Manager for the UNCDF-led Pacific Insurance and Climate Adaptation Programme, Mr. Krishnan Narasimhan congratulated FijiCare on the launch of parametric microinsurance in Tonga and shed light on the pilot project. He said, "UNCDF is privileged to partner with FijiCare in launching Tonga's first weather index parametric microinsurance product targeted at low-income households who are highly vulnerable to impacts of natural hazards.
