SPX Launches Women on Boards Publication

Suva, Fiji – The South Pacific Stock Exchange (SPX) has launched *Women on Boards of SPX Listed Companies*, the first publication of its kind in Fiji recognising women serving as directors on boards of SPX listed companies.

The publication captures women who served on SPX listed company boards during 2025. Beyond recognition, the publication aims to increase visibility of experienced women directors and serve as a practical reference point for companies and stakeholders when considering future board appointments.

The initiative was launched at the Ring the Bell for Gender Equality 2026 event as an action-oriented contribution by SPX in marking International Women’s Day 2026.

Commenting on the launch, SPX CEO Sheraj Obeyesekere said the publication reflects the exchange’s commitment to strengthening female representation on listed boards while recognising the women who dedicate their expertise and time to serving on the boards of listed companies. “By bringing their experience and leadership into one publication, we hope to both acknowledge the contribution of these female leaders and inspire more women to step forward into positions of leadership.”

He added that the profiles demonstrate the depth of capability and multi-industry expertise that exists among female business leaders operating at the highest levels of Fiji’s corporate sector. “We intend to update the

publication annually so that we continue to highlight female leadership across our listed companies and support stronger governance outcomes in the market.”
