These negotiated deals significantly influenced overall market performance during the week.

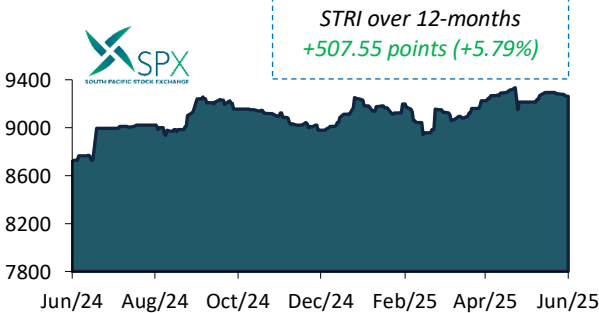

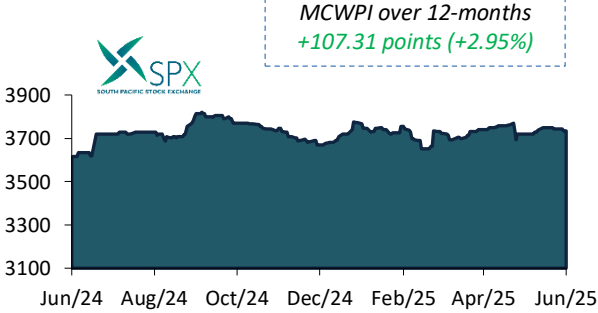

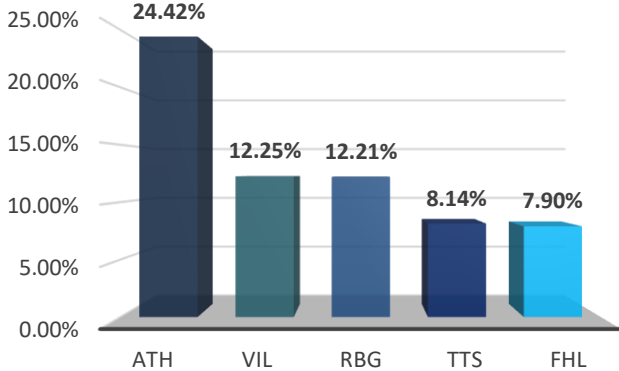
### SPX Total Return Index (STRI)
