This year, the Rugby World Cup (RWC 2023) will be hosted in France and will be the 10th edition of RWC and will take place 200 years from the moment William Webb Ellis picked up the ball in a game of football and ran, the action that birthed the sport of rugby!

Opening match kicks-off on Saturday 9th September at 7am Fiji time between the host nation, France and New Zealand.

All 48 matches from the 9th of September to the 29th of October will be shown Live and Exclusive on Fiji TV's free-to-air channel, Fiji One - The official home and channel of the Rugby World Cup since the inception of television service in Fiji.

Fiji is currently in thirteenth (13) in the latest World Rugby Rankings and will compete in Pool C alongside Wales, Australia, Georgia and Portugal.
