

Port Denarau Marina Launches \$6 Million Expansion – Home to the South Pacific's First Mega Yacht Berth

Denarau, Fiji – 22 September 2025 – Port Denarau Marina (PDM) proudly announces the completion of its landmark \$6 million Mega Yacht Berth Expansion, a transformative development designed to position Fiji at the forefront of global yachting destinations.

The project, which was completed over a four-month period, delivers seven new state-of-the-art berths, including Fiji's first mega yacht berth capable of accommodating vessels up to 115 meters - a milestone for the South Pacific. This expansion not only increases berthing capacity but also strengthens Fiji's competitiveness in attracting high-value superyacht tourism.

At the heart of the development is a 208-meter jetty extension, supported by advanced dredging works to deepen approach channels and turning basins, ensuring safe navigation and seamless access for the world's largest vessels. The expansion reflects global best practice, combining cutting-edge engineering with environmental care.

Key infrastructure includes the Super Elite® Marina System from Marine Structures (Australia), featuring elastomeric hinge technology that provides flexibility, rapid installation, and long-term durability with minimal maintenance. New utility pedestals supplied by Patron Power and upgraded fuel lines from Pacific Energy further enhance service reliability, offering superyachts efficient and modern connections for power and refueling directly at berth.



With this expansion, Port Denarau Marina now offers 62 private berths, including 27 dedicated for superyachts over 24 meters. This capacity boost not only supports visiting superyachts but also drives economic opportunities across Fiji's marine services, tourism operators, and local communities.

PDM Board Chair, Malakai Naiyaga, said:

"This is more than infrastructure - it is a forward-looking investment in Fiji's future as the leading superyacht destination in the South Pacific. It enables us to welcome the world's most prestigious vessels while generating local jobs, supporting marine tourism, and strengthening our position on the global stage."

The expansion is already proving to be a catalyst for Fiji's marine economy, with benefits reaching beyond berthing. From local suppliers and contractors engaged during construction, to the long-term opportunities for tourism, charter operations, and marine services, the project has set a new benchmark for regional maritime infrastructure.

Located just a 20-minute drive from Nadi International Airport, Port Denarau Marina is Fiji's premier marina facility and the gateway to the stunning tropical isles of Fiji's West Coast. As the hub of the integrated Denarau Island Resort, it serves as the central point for travelers and yachting enthusiasts exploring the region.

Port Denarau Marina offers convenient access to essential services, with a supermarket, pharmacy, and bakery right at the dock. Additional shopping and provisioning options are available in nearby Nadi and Namaka, just a short bus or taxi ride away..

Within walking distance of several international hotels, the marina is surrounded by a wide range of recreational activities, including an 18-hole championship golf course and Fiji's largest retail and restaurant complex. Whether for a short stopover or extended cruising, Port Denarau Marina is ideally positioned to provide rest, recreation, and provisioning services for visitors navigating the Fijian Islands.

As Fiji's leading yachting hub, Port Denarau Marina is accessed through a well-marked channel with a depth of 5 meters at zero tide, ensuring safe entry for vessels. The marina is well-protected from all weather conditions and features:

- 63 commercial and 62 fully serviced private berths
- 16 swing moorings
- 26 berths for Superyachts up to 115 meters with a 5-meter draft
- Fuel, water, single and three-phase power, and Wi-Fi at the dock
- A 30-tonne travel lift, hardstand area, and marine workshops
