**PDM ANNOUNCES THE RESIGNATION OF DAVID SKEGGS
AS A BOARD DIRECTOR**

The Chairman of the Board, Malakai Naiyaga, today announced the resignation of Mr David Skeggs as a Director of Port Denarau Marina Limited (PDML) with effect from 28 th February 2026.

Mr. Skeggs' resignation follows the completion of the sale of the Skeggs Group's remaining shareholding in PDML to Fijian Holdings Limited and FHL Trustees Limited. In light of this change in ownership, Mr. Skeggs has decided to conclude his long-standing service on the PDML Board.

Mr. Skeggs has served PDML with distinction over many years, including as Chairman during PDML's transition from a family-owned business to a publicly listed company on the South Pacific Stock Exchange on 14th August 2019. He stepped down as Chairman on 3rd November 2022 to support local leadership succession, and continued to serve as a Director thereafter.

The Board records its sincere appreciation for Mr. Skeggs' significant contribution to PDML and to Fiji's tourism development. His leadership, strategic insight and extensive industry experience have been instrumental in PDML's growth and success. The Board and Management thank Mr. Skeggs for his dedicated service and wish him well in his future endeavours.

The Board also confirms that Mr. Bryan Skeggs will continue to serve as a Director of PDML.

About Port Denarau Marina

Port Denarau Marina is Fiji's leading marina facility and the primary gateway to the stunning islands of the country's western region. Located just 20 minutes from Nadi International Airport, it serves as the central hub for maritime tourism and yachting in Fiji, connecting travelers to the heart of the South Pacific.

As part of the integrated Denarau Island Resort, the marina offers direct access to essential amenities, including a supermarket, pharmacy, and bakery at the dock. Additional provisioning and shopping options are available in the nearby towns of Nadi and Namaka.

Positioned within walking distance of several international hotels, Port Denarau Marina is surrounded by a vibrant lifestyle precinct featuring Fiji's largest retail and restaurant complex, along with an 18-hole championship golf course—making it an ideal base for both short stopovers and extended cruising.

Designed to accommodate vessels of all sizes, the marina features a well-marked entrance channel with a depth of 5 meters at zero tide, providing safe and reliable access. The facility includes:

- 63 commercial and 62 fully serviced private berths
- 16 swing moorings
- 27 superyacht berths for vessels up to 115 meters
- Dockside fuel, water, power (single and three-phase), and Wi-Fi
- A 30-tonne travel lift, hardstand area, and marine service workshops

Port Denarau Marina continues to set the benchmark for marine infrastructure and service in the South Pacific.
