We are confident that their skills and knowledge will contribute to the growth and prosperity of our Japanese stakeholders in Narita.”

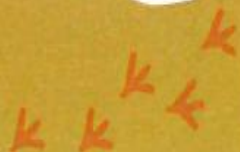
