Communications Fiji Limited (CFL), home of FM96, Viti FM, Navtarang, Radio Sargam, Legend FM, and the country's leading digital news platform Fijivillage, is excited to announce the launch of its new charitable trust, Communications Fiji Foundation (CFL Foundation).

For decades, CFL has been dedicated to community service, regularly stepping up to help children with special needs, those facing serious health issues like cancer, and families impacted by natural disasters. From fundraising efforts for cyclone relief to supporting individuals with terminal illnesses, CFL has built a strong reputation for making a real difference through its platforms.

As part of CFL's ongoing commitment to the Foundation, the Company will contribute 5% of the Group's profit after tax (PAT) each year. Based on the recently announced half-year results to June 30th, 2025, CFL will make its initial contribution of \$45,737.60, which is 5% of the Group PAT of \$914,752. This contribution marks the start of a steady funding source that will support the Foundation's work and growth.

The creation of the Communications Fiji Foundation makes official CFL's ongoing community efforts and establishes a way to expand the impact of these activities. The Foundation will be a dedicated channel for directing resources, coordinating programs, partnering with listeners and advertisers to build lasting projects that directly benefit vulnerable communities across Fiji and the Pacific.

CFL Chairman William Parkinson said, "We have always believed that our responsibility goes beyond broadcasting. The formation of the Communications Fiji Foundation, backed by a direct profit commitment from the company, allows us to better use the goodwill of our audiences, advertisers, and CFL team members to build a more resilient and caring society."

The Communications Fiji Foundation will soon announce its first projects and fundraising activities. It will invite the public and partners to work together with the CFL in creating positive change across Fiji.
